## Code of Conduct for Parents and Carers

This Code of Conduct is intended to establish a standard of behaviour amongst parents and carers when attending matches and training at Ansty Cricket Club.

Managers, coaches and senior captains have been entrusted by The Management Committee at Ansty Cricket Club to educate players about their conduct on and off the field of play.

Club officials, coaches and team managers all adhere to a strict code of conduct to ensure a high quality sporting experience is provided for your child in a safe and welcoming environment.

Please continue to attend matches and training as often as possible to support your son or daughter. Without the fantastic support of parents and carers, Ansty Cricket Club would struggle to function effectively.

**We ask that all parents or carers attending any training or match (home or away) adhere to the following.**

- Parents and Carers are not to go out onto the field of play at any time
- Parents and Carers are not to give advice about the game that contradicts that of the coach or manager at any stage during the game
- Parents and Carers are not to enter the dressing room at any stage of the match (should a player sustain an injury, this may be wavered at the discretion of the team manager)
- Unless invited to by a member of the team management, parents and carers are not to interfere with training or warm ups.
- Parents and carers are not to engage in discussion with the match umpires about incidents during the game
- Parents and carers are respectfully requested to refrain from passing adverse comment either verbally or in writing about the selection and the relative abilities of their own and other children.
