Ansty Cricket Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its young cricketers.

Ansty Cricket Club is fully committed to providing a high quality sporting experience for all of its young cricketers.

Ansty Cricket Club believes that it is important that its young cricketers, members, coaches, administrators and parents/carers or guardians associated with the Club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

Therefore, young cricketers, their parents/carers or guardians are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Shaun Janman (Club Chairman).

As a junior member of Ansty Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct for young cricketers:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late (this may be done via a parent or carer).
- All members must arrive in good time to help prepare the ground for home games, and stay after games / practice to ensure that all equipment is put away and the ground is left tidy.
- All members are expected to treat the Clubs facilities (changing rooms, nets and the ground) and, when playing away those of our hosts, with care and respect.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Ansty Cricket Club has a zero tolerance policy relating to the consumption of alcohol and drugs of any kind by its young members.
